GUIDELINE STATEMENT

The City/Township/Borough/Municipality of _____ Parks and Recreation Tobacco-Free Policy, Young Lungs at Play, is designed to protect the health welfare and safety of our park patrons.

MENT

The City/Township/Borough/Municipality of _______ is committed to providing a high quality of living for all residents. Therefore, we believe that:

- 1. Tobacco product use in proximity of children, youth, and adults engaging in or watching recreational activities is unhealthy and detrimental to the health of others.
- 2. Tobacco products once consumed in public spaces are often discarded on the ground, thus posing a risk of ingestion to toddlers and causing a litter problem.
- 3. As parents, leaders, coaches and officials, we are thought of as role models, and the use of tobacco products around youth has a negative effect on their lifestyle choices.

TOBACCO FREE FACILITIES

The City/Township/Borough/Municipality of ______ does not allow the use of tobacco products on City/Township/Borough/Municipality owned park land, park facilities, open space or joint City/Township/Borough/Municipality school district properties.

COMPLIANCE PROCEDURES

The emphasis on enforcing the Tobacco-Free Park policy is through voluntary compliance:

- 1. Appropriate town owned park land, park facilities, open space or joint town/school district properties will post Young Lungs at Play signage.
- 2. City/Township/Borough/Municipality staff will meet with activity organizations and/or leaders or coaches to discuss the policy and to distribute flyers with the "Tobacco-Free" regulations.
- 3. City/Township/Borough/Municipality staff will make periodic observations of activity sites to manitar compliance and halp to promote awareness of the tobacco-
